



WHEREAS, the City of Texas City on the 25 of August, 2017, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from Hurricane Harvey.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Texas City has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF TEXAS CITY:


That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Texas City, Texas pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Mayor of Texas City, Texas.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City of Texas City emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 25 of August, 2017.
